Three years ago the ‘Vitella Brothers,’ purchased a run-time neighborhood tavern called the Township House, located at 403 North Sycamore Street in Newtown, and rehabilitated into what has become one of the most popular eating and drinking establishments in the area. After completely gutting the building (with the exception of the bar which was refinished), The Saloon opened with a fresh new look, a fresh new menu, and a fresh new attitude; ‘cater to the customer.’

Within the confines of its newly renovated, intimate, upscale atmosphere, The Saloon now offers great Italian food, chops, steaks, pasta, veal, chicken and fresh seafood. At its handsome bar, which looks like it was retrofit from the 1920’s, patrons can enjoy top-shelf liquor, domestic and foreign beer, an array of specialty martinis and a superb wine list.
